## **Safe Driving Tips For Teenage Drivers**

1. Limit the number of passengers, the likelihood of an accident goes up tremendously with every passenger in the vehicle. (it creates distractions - see #5)
2. Pay extra **special attention when driving around the school** especially where younger children attend.
3. Do not talk or text on the cell while driving. (Active enforcement is now in effect/it is distracting - #5)
4. Do not eat while driving, it creates a distraction.(#5)
5. Learn the radio controls without looking, a distraction could kill you!
6. **Drive no faster than the speed limit!**
7. Do not ignore vehicle warning signs, such as vibrations, grinding brakes, low brake pedal, worn or low tires, check engine light, etc. (Call us immediately with any questions)
8. Always be sure you have good visibility (clean windows).
